Unfortunately, the Czech judiciary still refers to the conclusion of the expert that on the neck of Monika is the pale zone with reference to your publication: Knight's Forensic Pathology, 3Ed (Saukko, Knight's Forensic Pathology) and this is the only evidence that Mr. Petr Kramny is in jail for 28 years for an electric murder..

On August 8, 2013 the bodies were transported to the Czech Republic

On August 9, 2013, the so-called second dissection was held in Ostrava.

On January 30, 2014 diagnosis per exclusionem appears that the cause of death was acute heart failure after an injury by electrical current.

There are a number of contradictory conclusions in the case, but the court believed the version of the electric current, mainly because of the expert's conclusion, which states that the pale zone on Monika Kramná's neck is a clear and typical sign of electric injury. All other findings on the bodies are non-specific, they may lead to a number of different explanations of the cause of death.

No current trace was found on Mr. Kramny's daughter.

In the area of the only pale zone finding on Mrs. Kramná's neck, no metallization was found and the site of the alleged intervention has no vital reaction.

It is necessary to mention the written conclusion of prof. Ivo Steiner, a leading myocardial expert, that the findings on the myocardium of Mrs. Kramna and her daughter do not contain so-called contractions band and the conclusion about the effect of electric current is impossible.

We have been fighting for almost 6 years and have been trying to prove that no murder took place, but Czech courts insist on the conclusion of a local expert who is quoting your book (Knight, Bernard and Saukko, Pekka J. , 2004) that the only evidence of the whole murder is the pale zone on the neck of Monika Kramná.

Dear Professor, with all due respect and full trust, we ask your help in this extremely serious matter. We understand that the quality of the photo is low, but I have prepared for you a video from the repository, which relates to the pale zone on the neck of Monika Kramná and photos that, although in low quality, we have available.

Re: Help request - Pale zone

Dear Mr. Peričevič and Mr. Holovský,

thank you for your recent messages. I am sorry for the delay in responding.

Photographs are useful to document findings that have been observed at autopsy and verified by ancillary investigations such as histology. Cutaneous electrical marks are rather characteristic in areas such as palmar surface of the hands or plantar surface of the feet where the epidermis is thick. However, in areas where the epidermis is thin and / or the duration of the electrical current is short electrocution may produce no visible or only non-specific lesions.

The quality of the provided three photographs is far from optimal, and they do not allow the confirmation or exclusion of electrical burns as possible source of the changes.
